Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Carers

As the school year draws to a close, I'd like to thank you for your support throughout the year and also put forward two or three requests. The first is that you complete the **National School Opinion Survey** for parents. This nation-wide survey must be completed at least every two years. However we have chosen to seek feedback annually as the data for several of our Business Plan targets comes directly from several of the survey items. Those of you who have completed the survey previously will be aware that the items in Sections 2 and 3 of the survey are both fixed and mandated. In the following section, (Section 4) we have included several questions specific to Kapinara. In this section, we hope to capture the general feeling among families in terms of some of the programs we have run.

As you are aware, the more surveys completed, the more confident we can be that the responses reflect community perspectives. **The survey items are multiple-choice, and shouldn't take more than a few minutes to complete.** Unfortunately the survey doesn't cater for families with more than one child; so I suggest that you have one child in mind when you are responding to the items. There is a similar survey for Year 5 and 6 students and another for staff. I will include information on each of the data sets in the last newsletter of this year or one of the first newsletters next year. Thank you very much for making time to hit the radio buttons! You will receive a link to the survey via email tomorrow morning.

School Board in 2018

My second request pertains to determining membership of the School Board. If we receive more than two nominations for the two positions, I will ask the nominees to provide a short statement of introduction and will then ask the school community to indicate who they wish to have represent them in 2018. This will be via a Survey Monkey survey that will involve tapping another two radio buttons. I appreciate that this is a very busy time of year for most, and we've tried to ensure any surveys are quick and easy to complete. Please remember that the final date for School Board nominations is Friday, 1 December 2017 (**not** the 31 November as per the original email - sorry).

Unfortunately, from 2018 Independent Public Schools will no longer receive funding that has previously been available to support the administration costs of being an IPS, making the contributions of our school community even more critical. 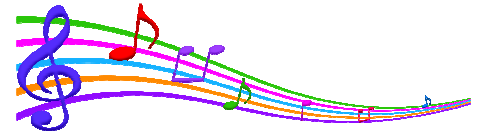
The uniform shop will be opened the Tuesday 30th January the day before school starts next year 9am-11am.
