

Animal Care Centre

Our animal care facility is in conjunction with the Shenton Park Dog Refuge Home and is located at 30 Lemnos Street, Shenton Park, open everyday from 11AM to 4PM.

If your dog is lost call the Town of Cambridge Ranger Services on 08 9347 6000 and follow the prompts. Alternatively you can call our animal care facility on 08 9381 8166 to see if your dog has been impounded. If your dog is wearing a registration tag the Town will contact you wherever possible.

Important Note: Dogs who have been impounded and are not registered, will not be released until registered with your local council.

Fines Information

If you do not comply with the Dog Act 1976 Regulations & Town of Cambridge Animals Local Law 2016, you may be issued an infringement. Below are some infringements that may be issued.

Unregistered dog	\$200
Dog not microchipped	\$200
Microchip details not up to date	\$200
Dog not wearing registration tag	\$200
Dog not held or tethering in a public place	\$200
Failure to control dog in exercise area	\$200
Failure to remove dog excreta	\$150
Failing to appropriately confine a dog to the premises at which it resides	\$200

Declared Dangerous Dogs incur double penalties.

Serious offenses may result in prosecution.

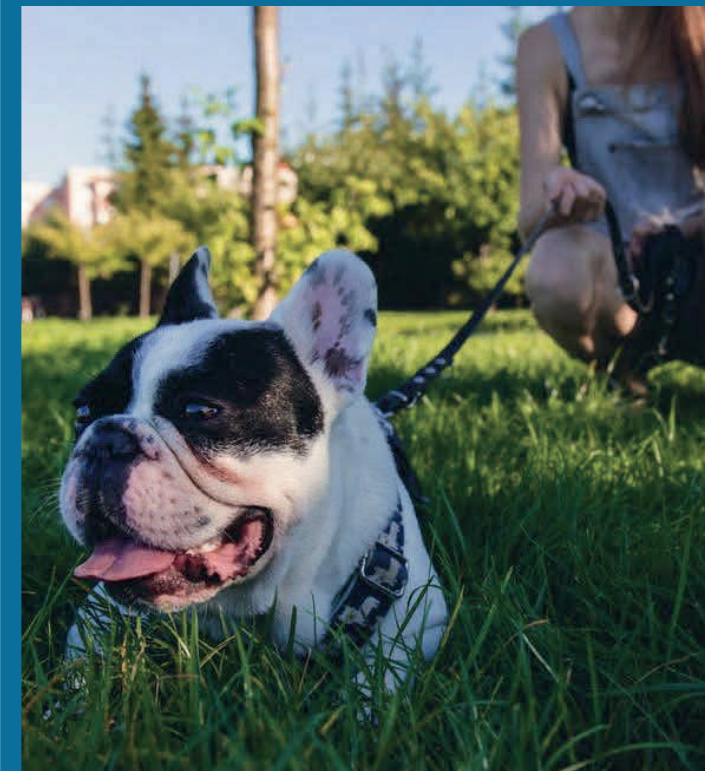

Your Dog and You

Your responsibilities as a dog owner



Dog Registrations

All dogs more than three months-of-age must be registered, and wear a current registration tag. Dog registration renewals are forwarded to registered dog owners in October of each year.

Dog Registration Fees:

1 Year

	Full Fee	Pension Concession
Unsterilised	\$50.00	\$25.00
Sterilised	\$20.00	\$10.00

3 Year

	Full Fee	Pension Concession
Unsterilised	\$120.00	\$60.00
Sterilised	\$42.50	\$21.25

Lifetime

	Full Fee	Pension Concession
Unsterilised	\$250.00	\$125.00
Sterilised	\$100.00	\$50.00

GST not applicable on fees.

Proof of sterilisation and entitlement is required to obtain fees at the reduced rates. Sterilisation proof can be given through a Veterinary Surgeons Certificate or a statutory declaration by the owner. If you sterilize your dog after paying the full fee, a partial refund will occur.

1 and 3 year registrations must be renewed before the 1st of November. If there are any changes to your address or contact details please notify the Town to ensure your dog is easily reunited.

Registrations can be made by post to PO Box 15, Floreat WA 6014 or in person at 1 Bold Park Drive, Floreat. Payments can only be made in person or over the phone.

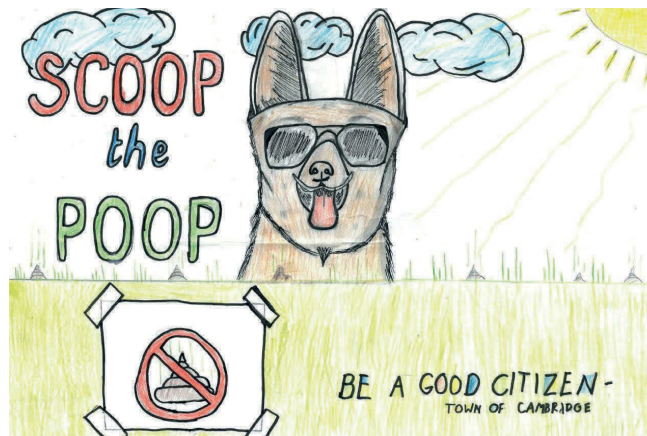
Responsible Dog Ownership

To be regarded as a responsible dog owner you must comply with the requirements of the Dog Act 1976. The wellbeing and safety of your dog and the community must also be regarded and therefore we ask owners to ensure their dog:

- Is registered and microchipped*.
*By having your dog registered with all details up to date ensures we will be able to find your pooch's home. Microchips may fail and therefore go hand in hand with registrations.
- Is appropriately confined at the premises at which it resides.
- Only exercised off-leash in designated areas and is capable of being controlled by the person. A leash must be carried to ensure your dog can be restrained if required.
- Wears current registration tag.
- Is kept out of playgrounds at all times.
- Doesn't leave behind any mess or faeces.

Most parks and reserves have dog waste bags to assist you to clean up after your dog. By doing so you are ensuring the environment is pleasant for everyone to enjoy.

Failure to comply with any of these requirements, could result in you being issued with an infringement.



Dog Exercise Areas

We encourage residents to exercise their dogs and the Town of Cambridge has plenty of dog exercise locations for your convenience. Main beach exercise areas for dogs are:

- North of Floreat Beach Pipeline
- South of City Beach

Main exercise parks for dogs are:

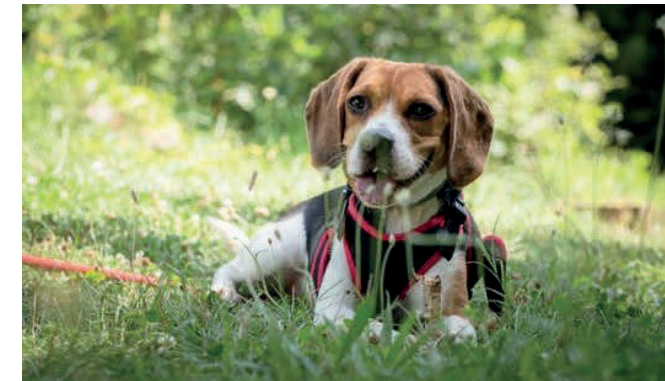
- Jubilee Park
- City Beach Oval
- Pat Goodridge Park (Lower Oval)
- McLean Park

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times at Perry Lakes Reserve and Lake Monger, unless otherwise stated by signage.

Always check signage before you unleash your pet. If you can't find a sign giving permission then the default setting is always "Dog on Leash At All Times".

Owners must maintain **effective control** of your dog when off lead. Effective control means:

- Able to be recalled on command.
- Not acting in a threatening or aggressive manner.
- Not to chase or disturb any person or wildlife.
- Does not cause damage to surrounding vegetation.
- Does not enter a lake or water body.
