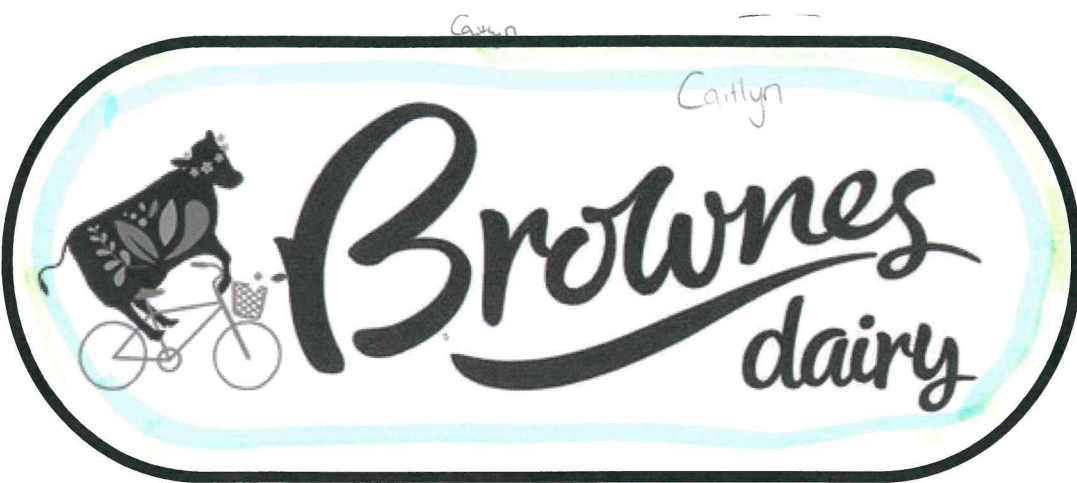




Mini Recount
